

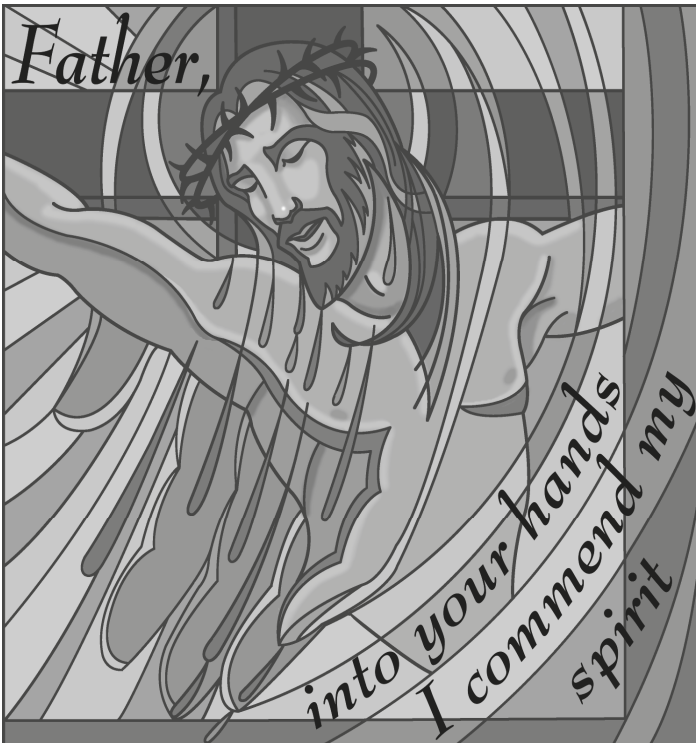

Dear Friends,

I would like to welcome all of our regular parishioners and our guests to this Sunday liturgical celebration that commences Holy Week, our most significant week of celebrations of the life of our Lord, Jesus Christ.

Today, we begin outdoors with a Gospel proclamation from St. Matthew extoling Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem at the beginning of Passover. We bless and wave palm branches as did Jesus' followers. However, the mood takes a dark turn at the proclamation of St. Luke's Gospel in the Mass. In this reading, we see that the brooding clouds of jealousy and ignorance of the scribes and Pharisees lead them to have the Roman authorities execute Jesus as a common criminal. Despite their desperate attempts to quash the Lord and His followers, we already know that he will rise from the Grave on Easter and thereby defeat our great enemy, our own deaths. And the Church He began continues to thrive to this very century and year. In Him, we have salvation and eternal life. We only need follow His Way, claim Him as Lord and Savior over us and trust in His promise of heaven for those who are indeed His own.

Note the schedule of Masses elsewhere in this bulletin for the coming Sacred Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday, which are one celebration observed over those three days). *Triduum* is Latin and means, literally "three days." They allow us to walk with Jesus and his Apostles and his blessed mother, Mary most holy, in the final days of His human life and into the tomb; They reach a crescendo on Holy Saturday when we find the grave empty, because He was raised by His Father. During the fifty days of the Easter Season, we will rejoice at His many appearances to his Apostles as well as His Ascension to heaven, and thrill to the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles at Pentecost, which closes the days of extended Easter exaltation.

The services for Holy Thursday and Good Friday will be about 1.5 hours in length. Holy Saturday will be about 2.5 hours in length. During the vigil, we will welcome 4 adults to our Christian Faith through the reception of the Sacrament of Baptism (*Please be advised that small children or those with certain health issues may find the mass uncomfortably long. Kindly use your best judgment and plan accordingly*).

For Easter Sunday, please note the regular Mass times: 7:30 am & 10:30 am (English); 9:00 am & 12:00 pm (Spanish); and 2:30 pm (Vietnamese).

Know that everyone is always welcomed at Sacred Heart Church on any Sunday, and particularly next Easter Sundays.

May God's abundant Grace and Mercy wash over you and draw you to attend Sunday Mass every week with this loving, accepting and contemporary Catholic community.

A NEW BAPTISMAL FONT PROJECT

The Sacrament of Baptism is our “gateway” (entrance) to the Church and the other sacraments. Through Baptism, God raises us up from the water and into new life. It’s the way Jesus has chosen for us to become adopted sons and daughters of his Body, the Church, and heirs with Him to the Kingdom of Heaven – “*reborn into New Life by water and the Spirit.*” (John 3:5)

Every time we enter the sanctuary, the prominence of the font serves as a reminder of our own baptism. It vividly displays the sacrament to our children and to our unbaptized visitors. Our Faith formation of future generations relies on the celebration of the sacrament of Baptism.

Recently, we discovered that our beautiful font is unfortunately beyond reasonable repair due to a serious leakage. Our Finance Council has made the decision to build a new traditional baptismal font. The new font will be installed in the same location to maintain the current aesthetic of the church. This addition is very important to me, because I want to continue celebrating this beautiful sacrament with our ever-growing community now and for years to come.
